

DELTA COLLEGE REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Dear Parents and Students:

This program allows students to enroll in classes at the community college while still in high school. At Millennium, we encourage students to take classes at Delta during Fast Track and during the year beginning as early as their sophomore year *and* when their school schedule allows. **Grades in high school classes are most important, and only students earning A's and B's in their high school classes will be approved to take a college class.** The classes should be geared toward meeting a general education requirement for a four-year college, but can also be an opportunity to explore different areas of study.

The partnership that we have with Delta College and the Early Start Program is a privilege. Allowing our students to attend classes in which we reimburse is a scholarship in and of itself; we hope you agree. As parents, we would like you all to be vigilant and supportive in our continuous endeavors to promote maturity, professionalism and good citizenship at all times.

Please note the following when discussing with your student whether to take a college class:

- ❖ **ALL CLASSES TAKEN at a COMMUNITY COLLEGE WILL BE PLACED ON THE MHS TRANSCRIPT.**

This means all grades will be factored into the GPA.

- ❖ **Students must maintain good attendance at MHS and satisfactory grades in order to enroll in college classes.**
- ❖ **Failing grades or withdrawing with a 'W' at Delta may result in losing the privilege of taking college classes the following semester.**
- ❖ **Classes taken at Delta must not interfere with your MHS schedule.**
- ❖ **Online Classes are not encouraged and students must meet specific criteria. Visit the Counseling Office, check out the Student Handbook online or the MHS website for details.**

It is important to remember that students should be able to maintain a high GPA at MHS while taking college classes as their MHS Transcript is the MOST important factor for college entrance!

- ❖ **Tracy Learning Center will reimburse students/parents for cost of tuition provided:**
 - **Students pass with a B or better.**
 - **Students return the College Reimbursement form along with the required documentation.**
- ❖ **Parents should pay for classes when student registers and seek reimbursement once classes are completed and grades are available.**
- ❖ **TLC does not reimburse students or parents for the cost of books.** Students may check the online Bookstore and click "Course Materials" to search for the cost of the books for a class prior to enrolling. Not all teachers for the same class require the same books. Millennium students may browse or list books for sale on our Counseling website. Click College Early Start, then scroll down to "View College Books for Sale" or "List Your College Books to Sell Here". There are many resources and other students provide great information!
- ❖ **Sometimes a student may have to register for a different class than what was listed on their CES form due to full or canceled classes.**
 - **Students must inform a Counselor when taking a class that is different from the one listed on the CES Form they turned in by completing the COLLEGE CLASS CHANGE FORM.**
 - **This form is available in the Counseling Office and online on the MHS Website.**
 - **Failure to do this will result in TLC NOT reimbursing the tuition. We must know what classes our students are taking.**
- ❖ **Students are responsible for getting the College Early Start (CES) form signed and turned into the Counseling Office for approval.**
- ❖ **Students must REGISTER online for their classes on or shortly after their assigned registration time or they will not be enrolled in the class. This does not happen automatically.**
- ❖ **As always, students may come into the Counseling office for help and/or guidance at any time during this process, but ultimately they need to be responsible enough to follow through! This is college after all. 😊**
